



RICH HISTORY Los Alamos

A SLICE OF HEAVEN WITH A SIDE OF TEXAS SOUL

Los Alamos, California was established in 1876 as a stagecoach stop and became a ranching hub. The name Los Alamos means "cottonwoods" in Spanish. The Los Alamos Valley was first home to a Chumash village, which was abandoned in the early 1800s. A new settlement of Chumash tended the cattle herds of the mission.

In 1821, Mexico broke free of Spanish rule and granted the Los Alamos valley to Antonio De La Guerra y Noriega. He named the ranch, "Rancho Los Alamos". In 1882, the narrow-gauge Pacific Coast Railway arrived, opening the town to the coast at Port Harford near San Luis Obispo. Los Alamos became a major shipping point for the area's agricultural products.



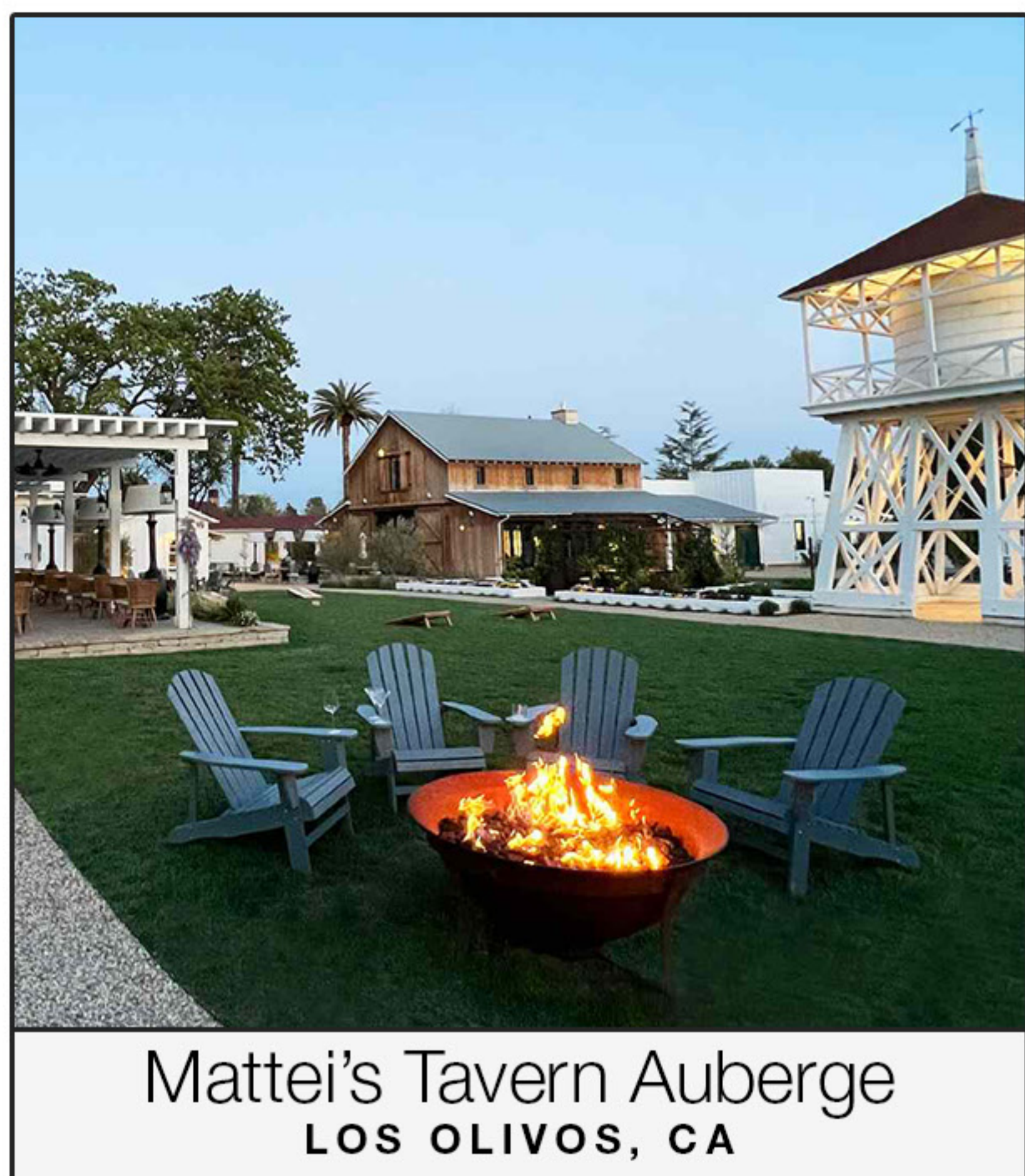
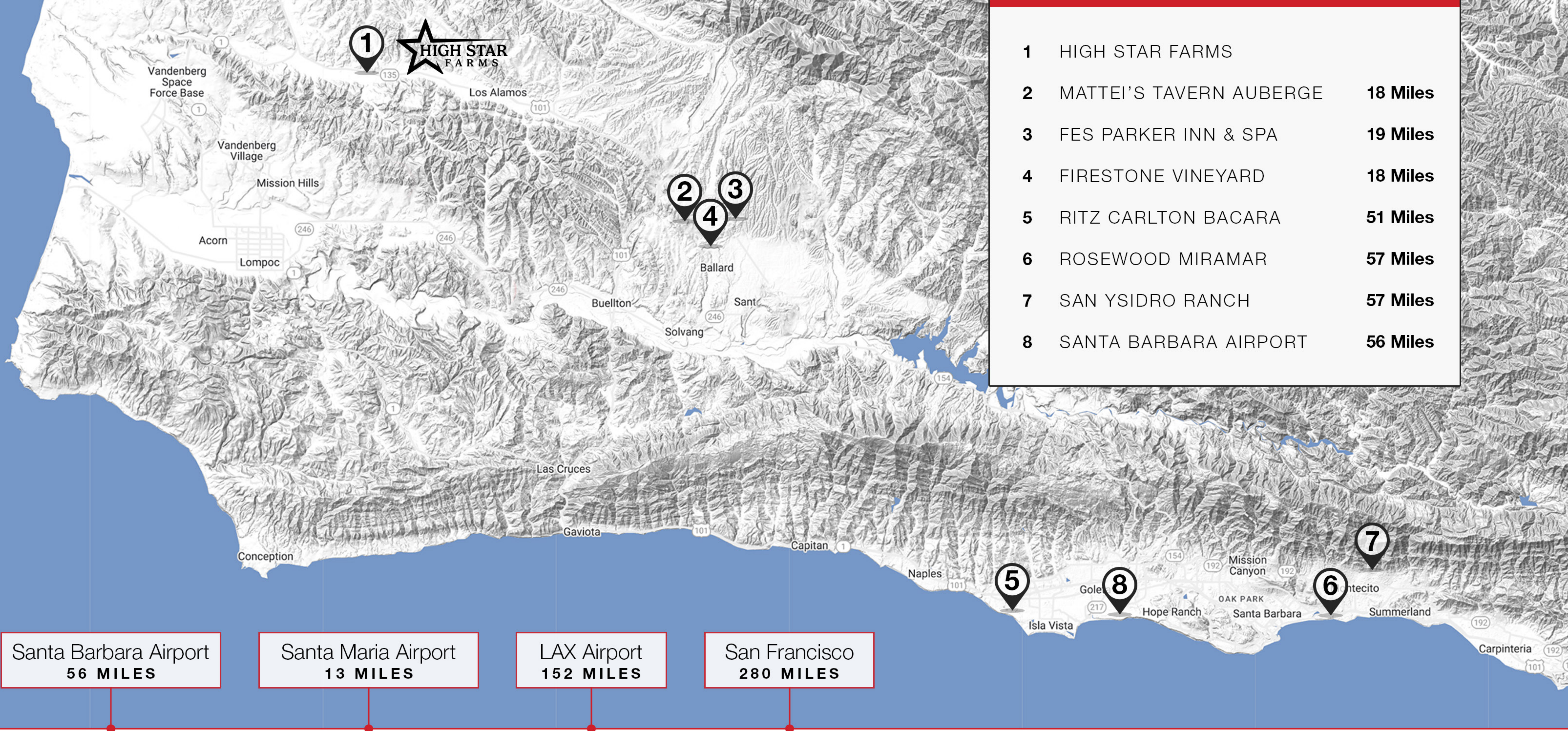
